Marin Show: **Art of the Americas** returns for its *27th year* as a showcase of **historic** and **contemporary indigenous art**

The annual Marin Show: Art of the Americas celebrates its 27th year February 26 and 27, 2011, as the most substantive and extensive ongoing showcase focused on the indigenous arts from across North, Central and South America. The show, produced by KR Martindale Show Management, has been described as the "Superbowl of Native American Art collecting." The exhibited art includes pottery, textiles, sculpture, jewelry, beadwork, baskets, paintings, photography and more, ranging in price from low \$100s to \$100s of thousands of dollars. The Marin Show works in association with the Antique Tribal Art Dealers Assoc., The Marin Museum of the American Indian, The Miwok Archeological Preserve of Marin, *American Indian Art Magazine*, and *Western Art Collector Magazine*.
