The Marin Show: Art of the Americas

The Marin Show: Art of the Americas celebrates its 26th year as one of the most substantive and extensive marketplaces focused on the indigenous arts from across North, Central and South America. The show, produced by KR Martindale Show Management, is described as the “Superbowl of Native American Art collecting”. Opening night preview on Feb. 12 benefits Homeward Bound of Marin. This year, the Marin Show partners with the long-running San Francisco Tribal & Textile Arts Show to create the First Annual Tribal Arts Weekend. Opening night preview for the SF Tribal Show on Feb. 11 benefits the de Young Museum. A \$15 ticket provides entry to both shows. Collectively, these art fairs showcase 400+ of the world’s most respected galleries, educational programming, local art exhibitions and cultural events, drawing art specialists, collectors, connoisseurs and enthusiasts from across the continents. The weekend is an anchor of the debuting ARTE DU MONDE SF, a weeklong celebration of cultural arts in the Bay Area. Lectures / presentations will round out the week, providing education and guidance for the tribal and indigenous art worlds.
